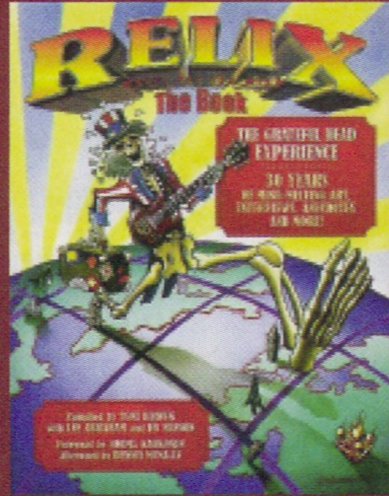


# Relix The Book
